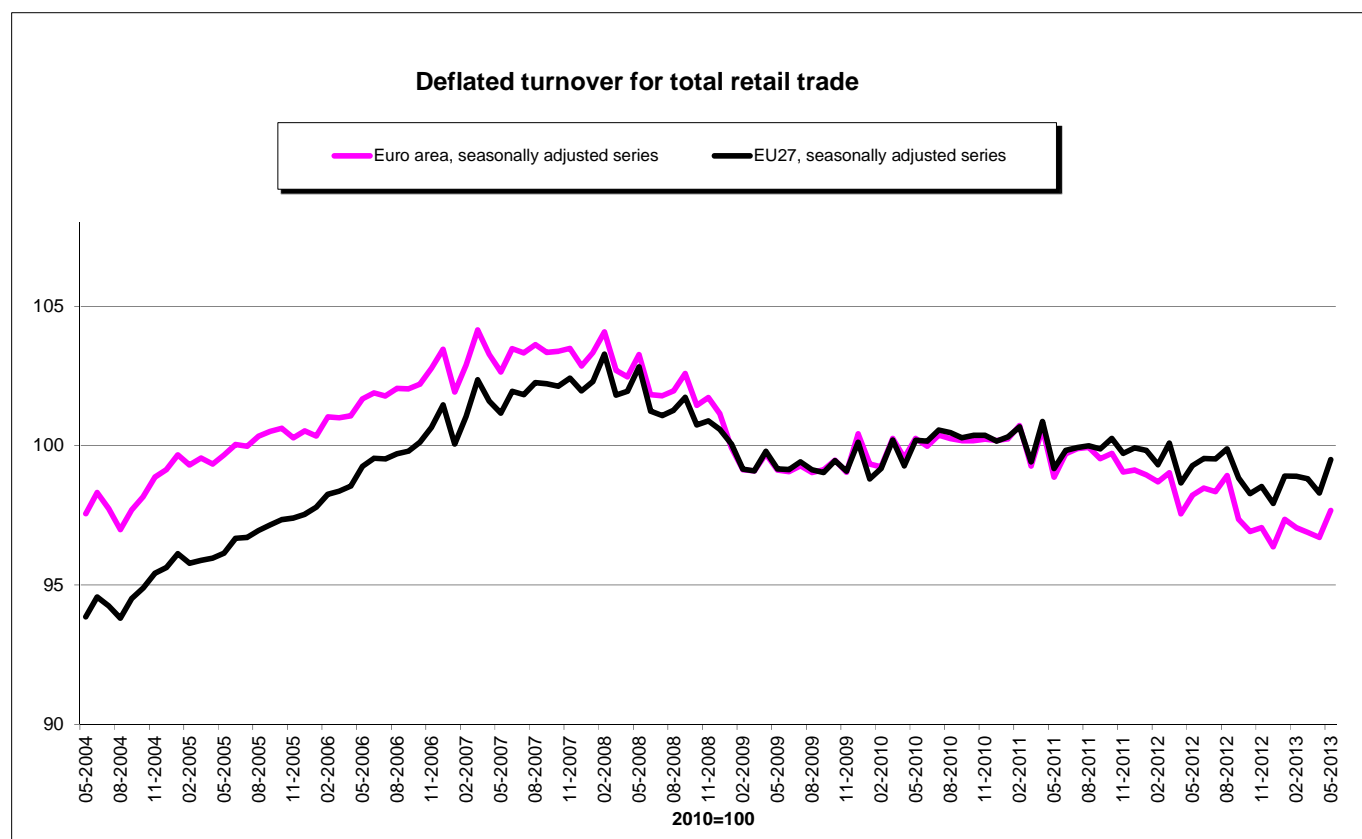
May 2013 compared with April 2013

## Volume of retail trade up by 1.0% in euro area

Up by 1.2% in EU27

In May 2013 compared with April 2013, the volume of retail trade<sup>1</sup> rose by 1.0% in the **euro area**<sup>2</sup> (EA17) and by 1.2% in the **EU27**<sup>2</sup>, according to estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In April<sup>3</sup> retail trade decreased by 0.2% and 0.5% respectively.

In May 2013<sup>4</sup>, compared with May 2012, the retail sales index dropped by 0.1% in the **euro area**, while it rose by 0.5% in the **EU27**.



## Monthly comparison

In May 2013, compared with April 2013, "Food, drinks and tobacco" increased by 0.9% in the **euro area** and by 1.5% in the **EU27**. The non-food sector rose by 0.9% and 1.0% respectively.

Total retail trade rose in all Member States for which data are available, except **Romania** (-3.0%), **Hungary** (-0.4%) and **Bulgaria** (-0.3%). The highest increases were registered in **Finland** (+3.6%), the **United Kingdom** (+2.8%), **Latvia** (+2.6%), **Estonia** and **Ireland** (both +2.4%).

## Annual comparison

In May 2013, compared with May 2012, "Food, drinks and tobacco" fell by 1.5% in the **euro area** and by 1.2% in the **EU27**. The non-food sector rose by 0.8% and 1.8% respectively.

Among the Member States for which data are available, total retail trade fell in seven and rose in fourteen. The largest decreases were observed in **Spain** (-6.3%), **Romania** (-4.4%) and **Portugal** (-3.6%), and the highest increases in **Latvia** (+8.0%), **Lithuania** (+5.8%), **Estonia** (+5.1%) and **Belgium** (+4.5%).

1. Based on data adjusted for working day and seasonal effects. Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects.

2. The euro area (EA17) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.  
Up to 30 June 2013, the European Union (EU27) included Belgium (BE), Bulgaria (BG), the Czech Republic (CZ), Denmark (DK), Germany (DE), Estonia (EE), Ireland (IE), Greece (EL), Spain (ES), France (FR), Italy (IT), Cyprus (CY), Latvia (LV), Lithuania (LT), Luxembourg (LU), Hungary (HU), Malta (MT), the Netherlands (NL), Austria (AT), Poland (PL), Portugal (PT), Romania (RO), Slovenia (SI), Slovakia (SK), Finland (FI), Sweden (SE) and the United Kingdom (UK). From 1 July 2013 the European Union (EU28) also includes Croatia (HR).  
As part of Eurostat's guidelines for the dissemination of data when the EU is enlarged, the aggregate data series commented on in this News Release refer to the official composition of the EU in the most recent month for which data is available. **Thus News Releases with data for months up to June 2013 will comment on EU27 series, while Releases with data for July 2013 onwards will comment on EU28 series.**

3. Data of previous months have been revised compared to those issued in the News Release 85/2013 of 5 June 2013. The monthly growth rates for April 2013 have been revised from -0.5% to -0.2% in the EA17 and from -0.7% to -0.5% in the EU27. The annual growth rate has been revised from -1.1% to -1.0% in the EA17 and remains stable at -0.6% in the EU27.
