

Discretionary Asset Management (Mandates)¹ – December 2013

On December 31, 2013, the total amount of the discretionary accounts (mandates) stood at EUR 54,546.6 million, which reflects an increase of 0.3 percent from the previous month.

Since end December 2012, Total Net Asset Value of discretionary accounts rose by 4.6 percent.

Management Companies

In December 2013, Caixagest was the Management Company with the largest market share, with total net assets standing at EUR 19,585.7 million, which represents 35.9 percent of the total. F & C Portugal ranks second, with total net assets of EUR 13,758.9 million and a market share of 25.2 percent, and ESAF – GP ranks third, with EUR 8,914.1 million of assets under management and a market share of 16.3 percent.

MNF Gestão de Activos was the Management Company that registered the highest growth, with a 6.8 percent increase over the previous month (EUR 1.1 million). The largest growth in total net assets belonged to ESAF - GP that increased EUR 375.2 million (4.4 percent).

Since end December 2012, Dunas Capital – Gestão de Activos is the Management Company registering the highest percentage growth with 94.6 percent (EUR 10.5 million), while ESAF – GP is the Management Company with the largest increase in total net assets with EUR 2,499.6 million (39.0 percent).

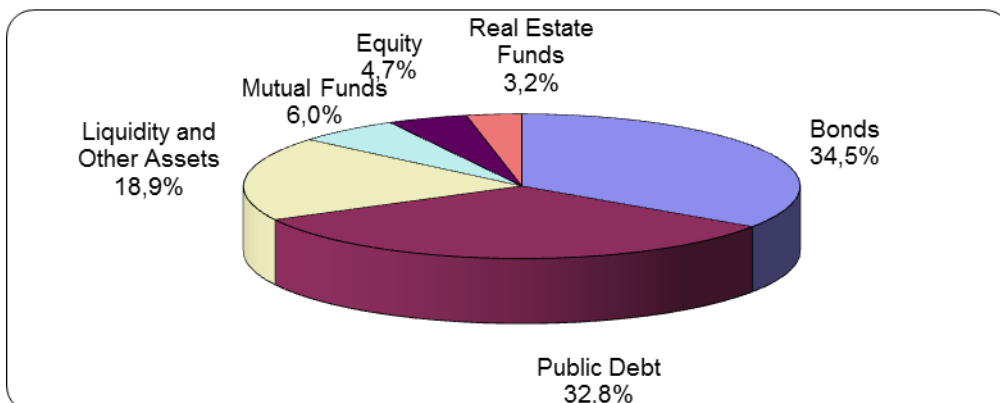

Discretionary Asset Management's Clients

Regarding the residence of clients, 96.9 percent of assets under management are related to Portuguese investors.

The majority of the portfolios under management belonged to Insurance Companies (67.0 percent of the total), followed by Pension Funds (17.6 percent of the total) and by Other Investors (11.1 percent of the total).

Discretionary Asset Management's Portfolio

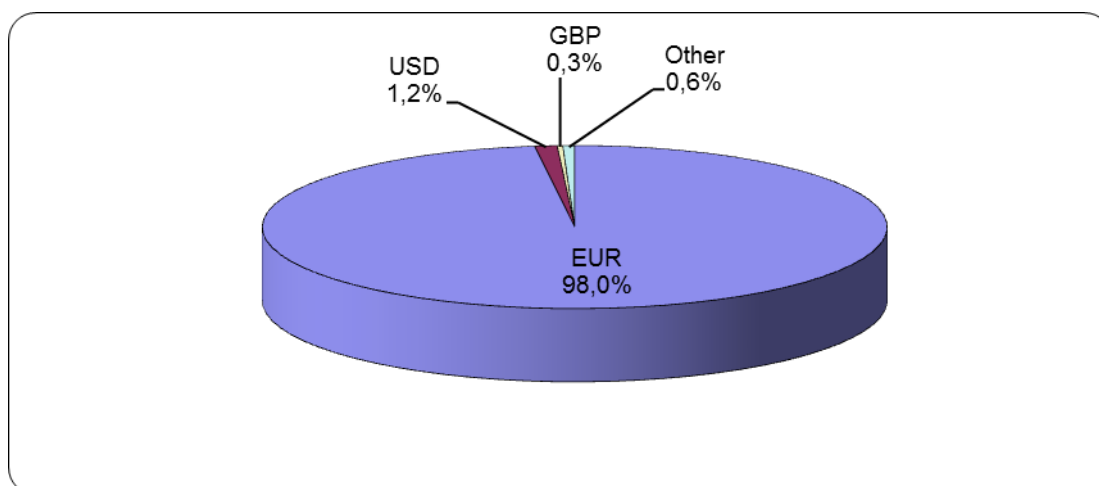


In December 2013, Corporate Bonds were the asset class with the biggest weight in the portfolios of Discretionary Asset Management representing 34.5 percent of the total holdings. Public Debt came second with 32.8 percent of total holdings.

During this month, Liquidity and Other Assets registered the highest increase in total assets' share, up 1.1 p.p. from the previous month.

Since end December 2012, Public Debt is the asset class with the highest growth in Discretionary Asset Management's portfolio, rising from 28.9 percent to 32.8 percent.

In December 2013, 98.0 percent of the assets held in the Discretionary Asset Management portfolios were denominated in Euro, 1.2 percent in US Dollar and 0.3 percent in Pound Sterling.
