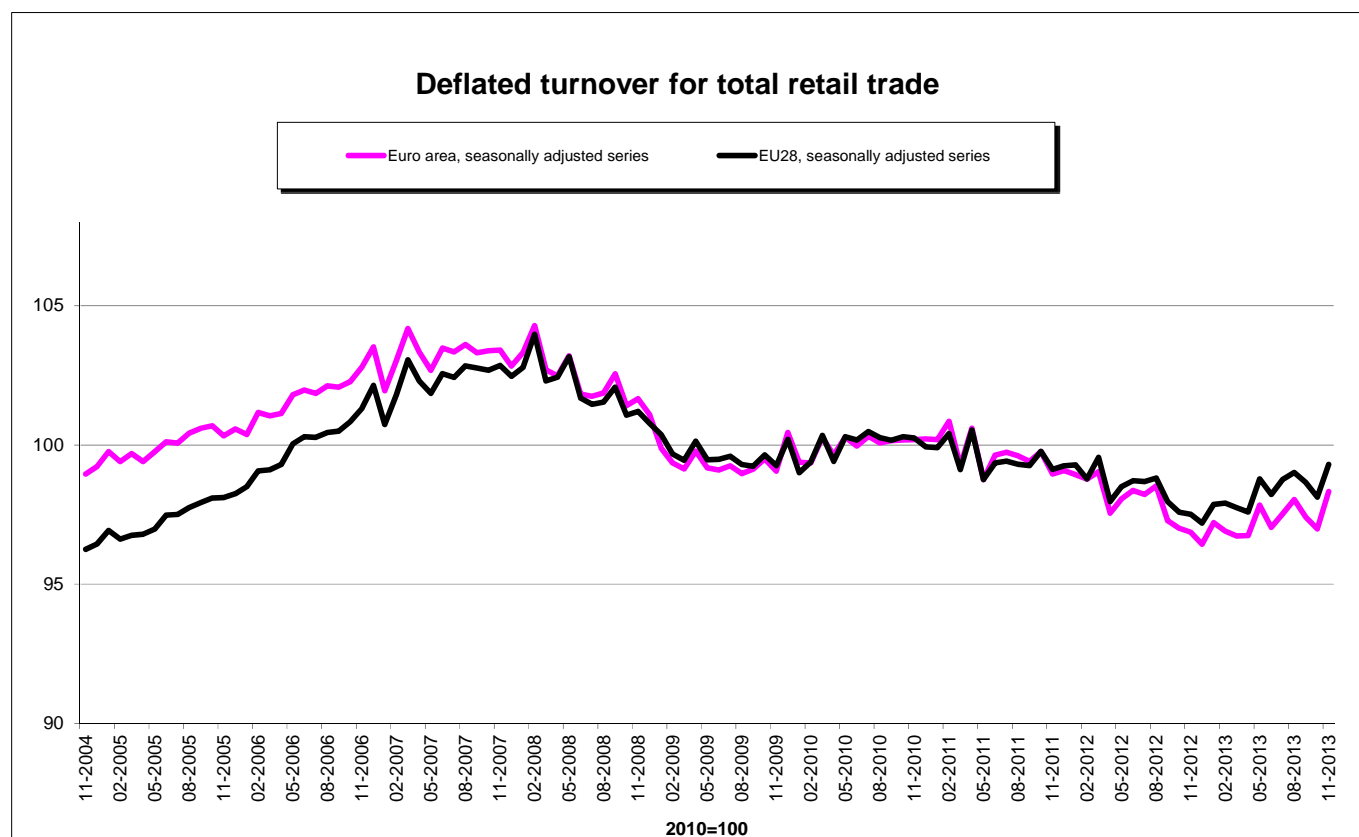
November 2013 compared with October 2013

## Volume of retail trade up by 1.4% in euro area

Up by 1.2% in EU28

In November 2013 compared with October 2013, the seasonally adjusted volume of retail trade<sup>1</sup> rose by 1.4% in the **euro area**<sup>2</sup> (EA17) and by 1.2% in the **EU28**<sup>2</sup>, according to estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In October<sup>3</sup> retail trade decreased by 0.4% and 0.5% respectively.

In November 2013 compared with November 2012<sup>4</sup> the retail sales index increased by 1.6% in the **euro area** and by 2.0% in the **EU28**.



## Monthly comparison

In November 2013 compared with October 2013, "Food, drinks and tobacco" increased by 1.1% in the **euro area** and by 0.9% in the **EU28**. The non-food sector increased by 1.9% and 1.7% respectively.

Among the Member States for which data are available, total retail trade rose in nineteen and fell in **Malta** (-2.1%) and **Romania** (-0.3%). The highest increases were registered in **Portugal** (+3.1%), **Luxembourg** (+2.3%), **France** (+2.1%), **Spain** and **Poland** (both +1.9%).

## Annual comparison

In November 2013 compared with November 2012, "Food, drinks and tobacco" rose by 1.4% in the **euro area** and by 1.1% in the **EU28**. The non-food sector increased by 2.4% and 3.3% respectively.

Among the Member States for which data are available, total retail trade rose in eighteen and fell in **Malta** (-0.6%), **Belgium** and **Finland** (both -0.5%). The highest increases were observed in **Luxembourg** (+12.6%), **Poland** (+7.2%), **Bulgaria** (+6.2%), **Estonia** (+5.7%) and **Latvia** (+5.0%).

1. The index of the volume of retail trade measures the evolution of the turnover in retail trade, adjusted for price changes (deflated), i.e. the evolution of the total amount of goods sold, based on data adjusted for working day and seasonal effects. Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU.

2. Up to 31 December 2013, the euro area (EA17) included Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland. From 1 January 2014 the euro area (EA18) also includes Latvia.  
The European Union (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.  
As part of Eurostat's guidelines for the dissemination of data when the euro area is enlarged, the aggregate data series commented on in this News Release refer to the official composition in the most recent month for which data is available.  
**Thus News Releases with data for months up to December 2013 comment on EA17 series, while Releases with data for January 2014 onwards will comment on EA18 series.**

The annual growth rates have been revised from -0.1% to -0.3% for the EA17 and from +0.5% to +0.3% for the EU28.
