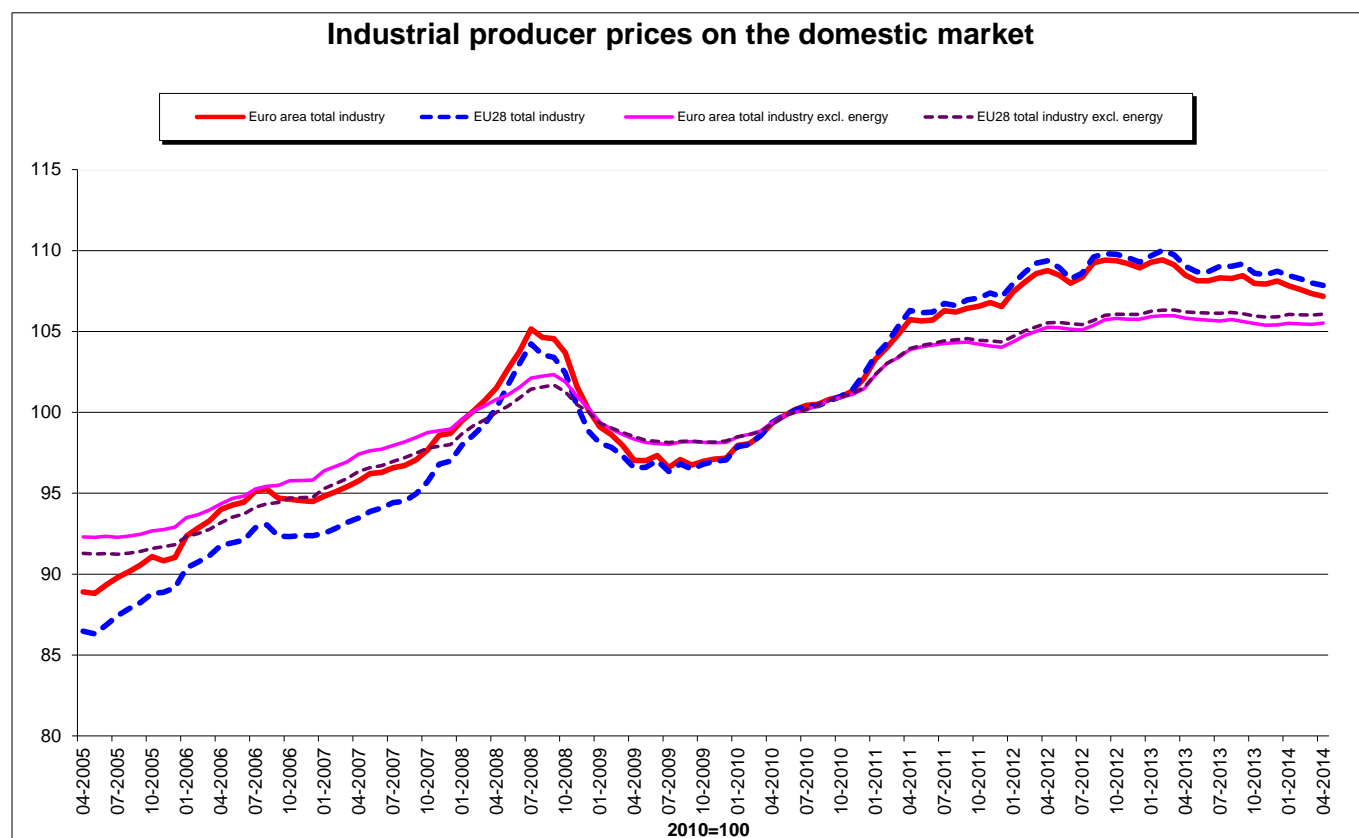


April 2014 compared with March 2014

Industrial producer prices down by 0.1% in both euro area and EU28

In April 2014, compared with March 2014, industrial producer prices¹ fell by 0.1% in both the **euro area**² (EA18) and the **EU28**², according to estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In March³ prices decreased by 0.2% in both zones.

In April 2014, compared with April 2013, industrial producer prices decreased by 1.2% in the **euro area** and by 1.1% in the **EU28**.



Monthly comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

The 0.1% decrease in industrial producer prices in total industry in the **euro area** in April 2014, compared with March 2014, is due to a fall of 0.7% in the energy sector, while prices remained stable for intermediate goods and capital goods, and increased by 0.1% for durable consumer goods and by 0.2% for non-durable consumer goods. Prices in total industry excluding energy rose by 0.1%.

In the **EU28**, the 0.1% decrease is due to a fall of 0.5% in the energy sector, while prices remained stable for intermediate goods, capital goods and durable consumer goods, and rose by 0.1% for non-durable consumer goods. Prices in total industry excluding energy increased by 0.1%.

The largest decreases in industrial producer prices were observed in **Malta** (-2.3%), **Belgium** (-1.5%) and **Sweden** (-0.6%), and the highest increases in **Romania** (+1.7%), **Greece** (+1.3%) and **Latvia** (+0.7%).

Annual comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

The 1.2% decrease in industrial producer prices in total industry in the **euro area** in April 2014, compared with April 2013, is due to falls of 3.3% in the energy sector and of 1.5% for intermediate goods, while prices rose by 0.3% for capital goods, by 0.7% for non-durable consumer goods and by 0.8% for durable consumer goods. Prices in total industry excluding energy fell by 0.3%.

In the **EU28**, the 1.1% decrease is due to falls of 3.3% in the energy sector and of 1.3% for intermediate goods, while prices rose by 0.4% for capital goods and by 0.8% for both durable and non-durable consumer goods. Prices in total industry excluding energy decreased by 0.1%.

Industrial producer prices fell in almost all Member States, with the largest decreases observed in **Belgium** (-5.1%), **Cyprus** (-4.7%), **Estonia** and **Slovakia** (both -4.6%), **Lithuania** (-3.7%) and **Croatia** (-3.0%), and the only increases in **Romania** (+1.1%), **Greece** (+0.8%), **Spain** and **Latvia** (both +0.1%), while prices remained stable in **Sweden**.

1. The index of producer prices shows (in the national currency of the country concerned) changes in the ex-works sale prices of all products sold on the domestic market, excluding imports. Euro area and EU indices refer to overall weighted price changes. The figures are not working day and/or seasonally adjusted. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU.

2. The euro area (EA18) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.
The European Union (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.
The tables also include Norway and Switzerland.
3. Compared with data issued in the News Release 71/2014 of 5 May 2014, the monthly growth rate for March 2014 remains unchanged at -0.2% in the euro area and has been revised from -0.3% to -0.2% in the EU28. The annual growth rates remain unchanged at -1.6% in both the euro area and the EU28.
