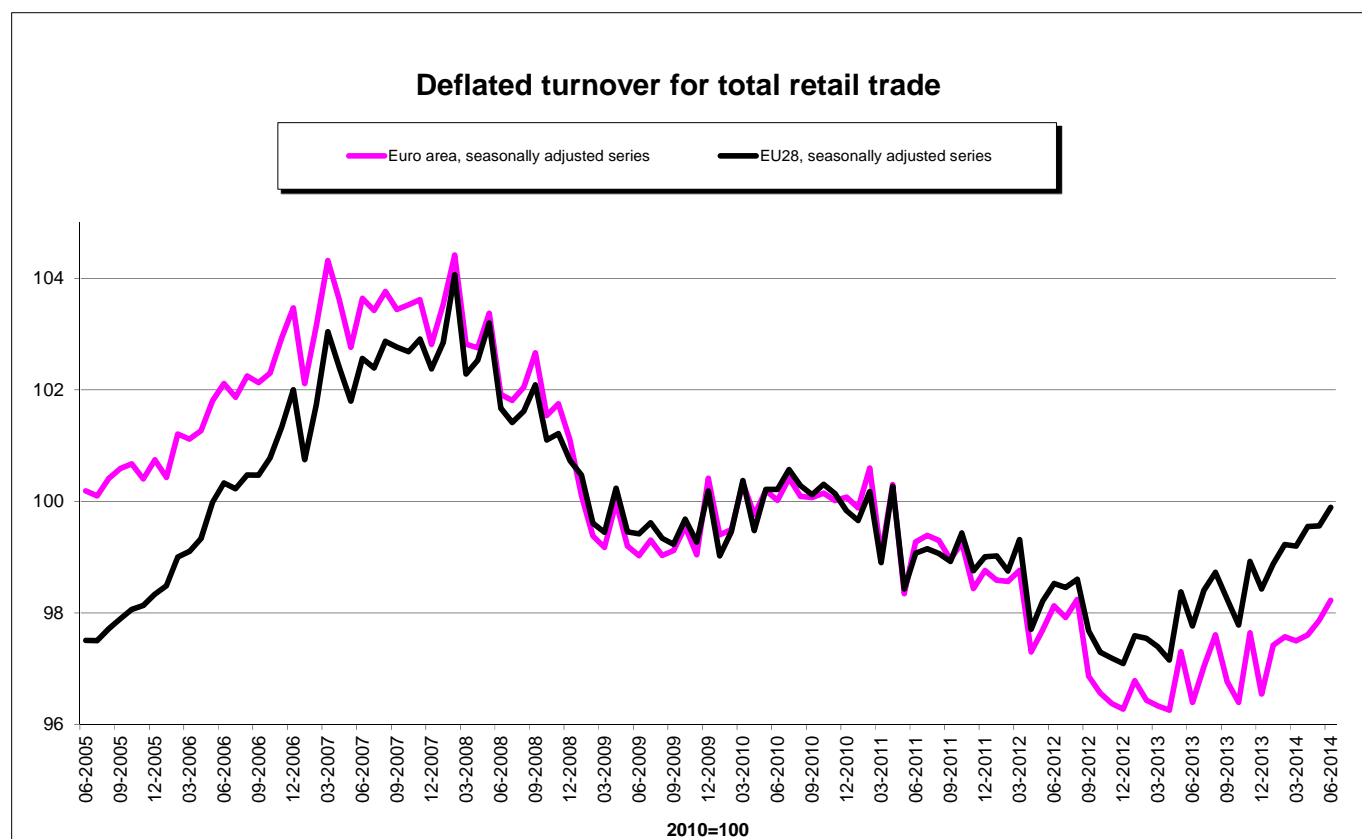
June 2014 compared with May 2014

## Volume of retail trade up by 0.4% in euro area

Up by 0.3% in EU28

In June 2014 compared with May 2014, the seasonally adjusted volume of retail trade<sup>1</sup> increased by 0.4% in the **euro area**<sup>2</sup> (EA18) and by 0.3% in the **EU28**<sup>2</sup>, according to estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In May<sup>3</sup> retail trade increased by 0.3% in the **euro area** and remained stable in the **EU28**.

In June 2014 compared with June 2013<sup>4</sup> the retail sales index increased by 2.4% in the **euro area** and by 2.5% in the **EU28**.



## Monthly comparison by retail sector and by Member State

The 0.4% increase in the volume of retail trade in the **euro area** in June 2014, compared with May 2014, is due to rises of 0.5% for “Food, drinks and tobacco” and of 0.3% for the non-food sector, while automotive fuel fell by 0.1%. In the **EU28**, the 0.3% increase in retail trade is due to rises of 0.5% for “Food, drinks and tobacco”, 0.3% for automotive fuel and 0.2% for the non-food sector.

The highest increases in total retail trade were registered in **Germany** (+1.3%), **Austria** (+1.1%), **Poland** (+1.0%) and **Estonia** (+0.9%), and the largest decreases in **Finland** (-1.8%), **Portugal** (-1.4%), **Malta** (-1.1%) and **Spain** (-0.8%).

## Annual comparison by retail sector and by Member State

The 2.4% increase in the volume of retail trade in the **euro area** in June 2014, compared with June 2013, is due to rises of 3.0% for the non-food sector and of 2.0% for “Food, drinks and tobacco”, while automotive fuel decreased by 0.8%. In the **EU28**, the 2.5% increase in retail trade is due to rises of 3.5% for the non-food sector and of 1.8% for “Food, drinks and tobacco”, while automotive fuel decreased by 0.5%.

The highest increases in total retail trade were observed in **Luxembourg** (+12.9%), **Romania** (+10.0%), **Estonia** (+7.8%) and **France** (+4.9%), and the largest decreases in **Slovenia** (-2.6%), **Finland** and **Malta** (both -1.5%).

1. The index of the volume of retail trade measures the evolution of the turnover in retail trade, adjusted for price changes (deflated), i.e. the evolution of the total amount of goods sold, based on data adjusted for working day and seasonal effects. Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU. The euro area (EA18) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland. The European Union (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom. The tables also include Norway and Switzerland.
3. Data of previous months have been revised compared to those issued in the News Release 105/2014 of 3 July 2014. The monthly growth rates for May 2014 have been revised from 0.0% to +0.3% in the euro area and from -0.1% to 0.0% in the EU28. The annual growth rate has been revised from +0.7% to +0.6% in the euro area and remains unchanged at +1.2% in the EU28.
